

May Flowers - BOM Raffle Drawing

To make your flowers pretty and springy use a bright spring color fabric in a small print or reads as solid. Other colors are suggested below, the stem and leaves can be the same fabric if desired.

Fabric Needed and Cutting Instructions: (label your pieces with the Piece # as you cut them)

Flower petals - one fat eighth

- Cut - Piece A, cut 4 - 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" squares
- B, cut 2 - 2" x 4 1/2" rectangles
- C, cut 2 - 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles
- D, cut 2 - 3 1/2" x 4" rectangles

Flwr center (yellow) - Piece E, cut 1 - 3 1/2" x 5 1/2" rectangle

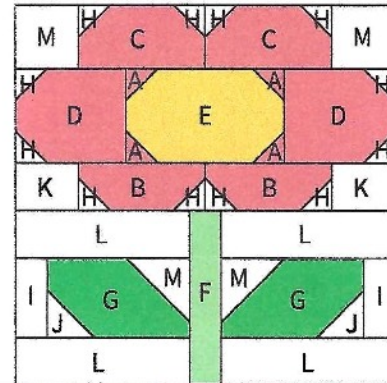
Stem (light green) - Piece F, cut 1 - 1 1/2" x 6" rectangle

Leaves (darker green) - Piece G, cut 2 - 3" x 5" rectangles

Background (white or ivory) - one fat quarter

- Cut - Piece H, 12- 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" squares
- I, 2 - 1 1/2" x 3" rectangles
- J, 2 - 2" x 2" squares
- K, 2 - 2" x 2 1/2" rectangles
- L, 4 - 2" x 6" rectangles
- M, 4 - 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares

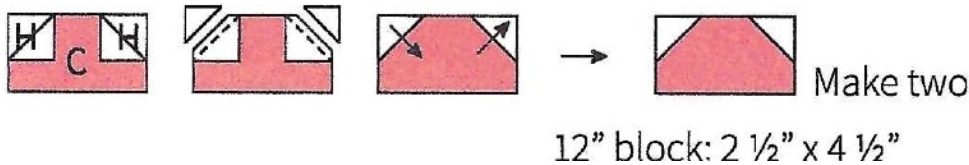
Fabric Label Diagram



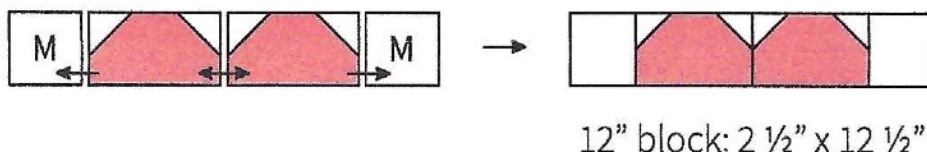
Block Assembly

Follow these instructions, using a 1/4" seam, for a 12" finished (12 1/2" unfinished) block:

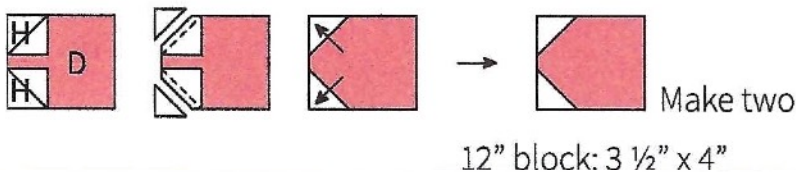

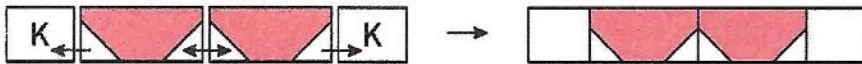

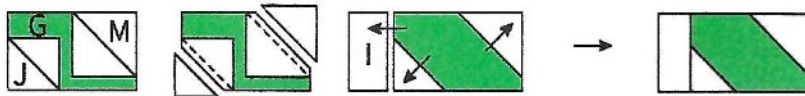

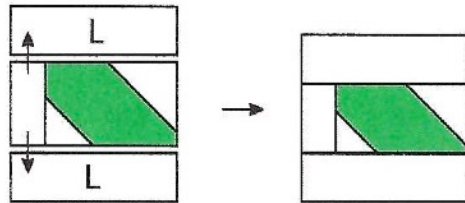

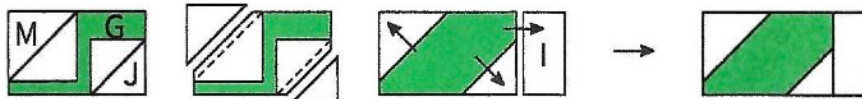

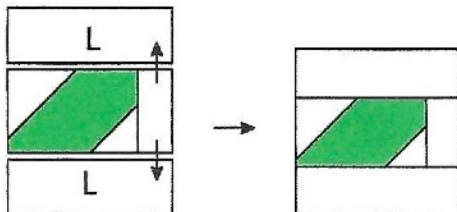

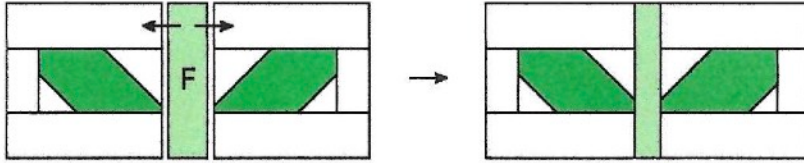

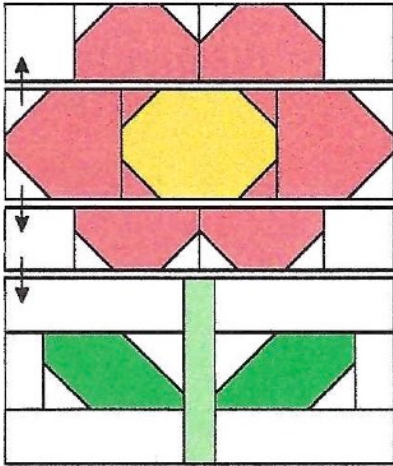
