QGET Minutes

First Christian Church – June 8, 2023

The meeting was called to order by 1st Vice President Cindy Newland at 10:00 AM. Guests, new members and returning members were welcomed.

Announcements – Lanie Schrink has brought the Plano Guild Raffle Quilt and is selling tickets in the lobby. Members were urged to view the quilt. The Board decided to have a contest to design a guild-related emblem for the guild T-shirt. Design should be 3 colors or less. Members were invited to submit original designs by the August meeting, and send to President Gary by email. A secret ballot will be held at September general meeting.

The minutes of the May General meeting were posted in the newsletter. Additions or corrections were queried. Hearing none, minutes approved as published. Treasurer Report – The Treasurer's report is posted in the lobby. Any questions should be directed to Deborah Monroe, Treasurer.

1st Vice President – **Cindy Newland** –Hive plans are a demonstration of Yo Yos and members were invited to make some yo yos. No Hive in July due to Veteran's Picnic. In August, new and current members will have an opportunity to ask questions about guild activities in a "sit down" event.

2nd Vice President – **Mitzy Pearson-** Mitzy announced workshops will now meet at 9AM and held in the Christian Living Center. Members can enter through North door. Today Sherilynn Mortensen will present a Trunk Full of Curves show of her quilts made from her patterns and show rulers used to make the blocks. The Friday Posh Santa Workshop has openings and will be held in the Contemporary Worship Center. In July we will have the Veteran's Picnic and no speaker. A free Sew Day is planned instead of a workshop, to be held in the Christian Living Center room. Members were asked to sign up for this day. In August Catherine Cureton, a pattern designer, will provide a Trunk Show. No workshop is planned for August as there is a bus trip planned for the Plano Quilt Show. In September Annette Plog will present a program on Building a Stash That Works. She will present a workshop on paper piecing.

Membership – **Letha Sparks** –We gained two new members today, bringing membership to 206 members. A notice will be sent to members to assist renewing membership.

2024 Quilt Show – A contract has been signed to have the quilt show at the church. A theme still needs to be identified.

Social Media/Communications – **Lucinda Cox** – Lucinda invited members to visit the website and get familiar navigating the various links. Information to be placed in the monthly newsletter needs to be submitted to Lucinda by the 20th of the month. Lucinda asked for someone to volunteer to help with the guild Facebook page.

Community Projects – **Cyndi McNeill**- Thirty quilts were delivered to the Children's Advocacy Center. The CAC has a new building and guild members will be informed when the Grand Opening is planned so we can tour the facility. Additional organizations have requested quilts to be donated, such as the Hope Haven and Royal Family Kid's Camp. Dog beds are being made for Angel Pond and SPCA. Cyndi asked members to donate 1 yard of fabric, plus fabric scraps, to be used for making the dog beds. A Community Service Sew in Day will be held at the First Baptist Church on Tuesday, June 20 from 10AM to 3PM .

Event Coordinator – **Pat Graham** –The Veterans Celebration program planned for July 13 will be held in the church sanctuary and Quilts of Valor will be awarded. A short business meeting will precede the picnic. A request was made for people to donate watermelon chunks, and to serve food. A list was passed around for members to sign. Members were asked to wear red, white and blue clothing. Food donations have been completed and programs printed with veteran information. Members were asked not to reserve seats for picnic but to allow veterans to be seated first, then fill in open seats. Pat has 153 reservations for the lunch. Seven QOV were awarded last week at a Camp V ceremony. Two quilts will be awarded Friday at a Women's Veteran ceremony.

The Plano Bus trip, August 11, has openings and members were urged to sign up and pay for the trip online.

Bee Keeper – **Maresa Campbell** – Open Bees were reported (Bee Creative, Bizzy Bees, GLOB, Piece Makers, Sew Joyful) and meeting information is included in the current Newsletter. Anyone needing help in finding a Bee of interest, or if is interested in starting a Bee, contact Maresa.

Sunshine and Shadows/Deals or Duds – **Rhonda Chapman**. Serena Vrnak, lifetime member, passed away recently. **Deals:** Rhonda suggested for members with the scan and cut machine to try waxed paper on fabric to help in fabric cutting.

Reception – **Kathy Burns** – 70 members attended today. New members were identified by name and welcomed. Door prizes donated by Country Store, Joyful Threads, Susan Branscum and Options Quilt shop were awarded.

Mitzy Pearson introduced the speaker. She presented a program featuring quilts made from patterns she designed and using rulers for curved piecing, straight piecing and machine quilting. These techniques will be used in tomorrow's Posh Santa workshop. Openings available for workshop.

Show & Tell was completed.

Meeting closed at 11:42 AM.

Utilizing the Wedge Star® tool the student will be able to construct two or three blocks in class and leave with the confidence and expertise necessary to complete this quilt and the inspiration for many others.

November Program – Giuseppe Ribaudo, aka Giucy Giuce – November 9, 2023

Giuseppe Ribaudo (aka Giucy Giuce) grew up in Long Island, NY. First generation Sicilian-American on his dad's side and second on his mom's, his

family lived on the bottom floor of his maternal grandparents' house. His grandmother is a talented and prolific seamstress who taught him to sew at an early age, though it wasn't until he was in college that he discovered quilting. Giuseppe joined Instagram, shortly thereafter and quickly found himself making long distance friends in the quilting community via social media.

After having bounced around the country for about a decade Giuseppe moved back New York to pursue a career in textiles. Within a few months of being in NYC he was offered a marketing position at Andover Fabrics and was promoted to multimedia manager a year later. In 2018, he turned his focus to fabric design and released his first collection Quantum. In 2021 he released his tenth collection called Nonna, an homage to his grandmother and her home where he learned to sew. Nonna led Giuseppe to an Italian holiday collection to be released in summer of 2023 called Natale.

Giuseppe currently resides in Portland, Maine where he continues to design fabric and patterns and teach quilting classes.


