Sarah is also an <u>engineer at NASA's Johnson Space Center</u>, where she began as a college student in 1997. She's had several different jobs over the years and while they've all been fun, her most "glamorous" role was working as a flight controller for the space shuttle from 2005-2011. Our Community Projects sewing group has a new name... **The Giving Bee!** We had a great turnout on January 18th, and we pieced backings for quite a few Cuddle Quilts. The next Giving Bee sewing day will be Tuesday, February 20th from 10:00 am to 3:00 pm at First Baptist Church (301 W. Ferguson). Come join us!

#### CUDDLE QUILT PANEL CHALLENGE!!

We are so excited to announce another Panel Challenge being hosted by Cuddle Quilts. All you have to do to participate is sign up with Becky Grimaud at the Cuddle Quilts table at any guild meeting. Becky will give you a quilt kit complete with a panel, coordinating fabric, and backing and binding fabric. (Or you can use your own panel and fabric if you like.) Your finished quilt will be turned in at our *July guild meeting* to be voted on by our members, and the quilt makers in the top 3 places will win great prizes. The design of your quilt is entirely up to you! Add as much or as little to your panel as you want, just try to keep your quilt within the size range of 40" x 50" (smallest) to 60" x 80" (largest). If you need some design ideas Becky and her team will be happy to help you. We will also be happy to supply you with batting when you get ready to quilt, or just turn in your quilt top and backing fabric if you would rather one of our volunteer longarm quilters quilt it for you. (Please make sure you give the quilter plenty of time to finish it though!)

This challenge is a great way to get involved in our Community Service efforts, and we hope you will join us. For more information just contact Becky Grimaud at grimaudr12@gmail.com.

Hi, I'm Ellen Baranowski, I am the new Bee Keeper. There seems to be a need for some new Bee's.




