STEP 2 - 4 Patches





Quilt A

- 1. Sew one 2 ½" strip of light fabric to one 2 ½" strip of black fabric to make a strip set. Make 3 sets. Press seams toward black.
- 2. Sew one 2 ½" strip of medium light fabric to one 2 ½" strip of black fabric to make a strip set. Make 3 sets. Press seams toward black.
- 3. Cut 36 2 ½" strip units from each group of strip sets.



4. Sew 2 strip units together to make a 4 patch.



Make 18 light/black 4 patches (set aside for Step 5) and 18 medium light/black 4 patches.

Quill B & C

- 1. Sew one 2 ½" strip of light fabric to one 2 ½" strip of black fabric to make a strip set. Make 1 set. Press seams toward black.
- 2. Sew one 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip of medium light fabric to one 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip of black fabric to make a strip set. Make 1 set. Press seams toward black.
- 3. Cut 16 $2\frac{1}{2}$ " strip units from each group of strip sets.



4. Sew 2 strip units together to make a 4 patch.



Make 8 light/black 4 patches (set aside for Step 5) and 8 medium light/black 4 patches.
